


2022 Maumee Bay State Park Rendezvous



Friday, June 24 to Sunday, June 26

Maumee Bay State Park is located off the Maumee River due south of the shipping channel Marker 29 about 2.5 miles away. The park monitors channel 69. The club will use channel 69 for communication. If you are interested in traveling with a group, please reach out on the Facebook page and see when folks are leaving.

You should have paid your deposit to hold your dock. Check in at the front desk after your arrival to finish the reservation process. Dockage is \$2.25/ft/night. Any questions, feel free to call Steve Sump on his cell phone at 216-272-2214. The park's telephone number is 419-836-1466.

Each dock is equipped with power and water, however, the distance to water may be a little long. Bring an extra hose and y-connection if you have them. Each dock is equipped with single 30/50 amp service. Bring a splitter if you require more than 1 electrical hookup.

There is no bathhouse/bathroom facility located within the marina; we all will get pass keys to use the lodge facilities, available all times. The park has many amenities so plan for a fun getaway weekend. Some optional items to bring include: bikes, dock chairs, beach fun apparel and equipment, sunscreen, etc. We will be allowed to use the lodge pool during their posted open times. Other lodge facilities will be open on a limited basis so plan accordingly with food and beverage supplies.

We will have informal BYO cocktails and snacks on the back of the boats Friday night.

The club will provide a cookout meal on Saturday. The club will furnish smoked brisket and chicken, buns and baked beans. Please plan to bring your own condiments, side dishes, cooking utensils, table service, plates and beverage.

Please remember, we are in a state park where alcohol is not permitted; please keep it on your boat.
